ICB Sunday School Student and Parent Guidelines

I. MISSION STATEMENT OF ICB SUNDAY SCHOOL

Our Sunday school is based on the Islamic values in the light of Quran and Sunnah. We are committed to providing an environment of learning by which students see their faith as a guide and source of strength in their daily lives.

II. GENERAL

Our Sunday school is a non-profit school run by the ICB community. All administrators, teachers and volunteers at the ICB Sunday School (“School”) are serving our community by supporting the Mission Statement of the School.

The Sunday school is a joint project of the community, students, parents, and volunteers. The success of the School largely depends upon the engagement and commitment from all parties involved.

Students and parents/guardians of students are to follow the guidelines set forth in this document. Parent’s support, cooperation and encouragement are critical for student’s academic success.

III. STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

The School is committed to creating a secure environment for learning. Please take adequate time to review this code of conduct with your child.

A. Attendance

1. Regular attendance is important for continued learning. While the School recognizes that families may have other obligations on Sundays that at times may cause students to miss class, attendance in

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school is required for continued admission. Exception may be made on a case-by-case basis by the Administration

2. Parents should make every reasonable effort to communicate when a child is absent by emailing the student's teachers before class begins, and include the reason for the absence
3. No student shall be dismissed during school hours without a written request from his or her parent, stating the reason and time for dismissal
4. ICB follows the Boise School district calendar

B. Student Responsibilities

1. Students are expected to follow school and class rules as set by their teachers and School Administration
2. Students are required to respect the school teachers and volunteers, to show consideration for others and use good manners
3. Come to class prepared; bring all necessary materials to class
4. Unacceptable behaviors by students, including but not limited to, breaking classroom rules, refusing to follow directions, pushing or harming others, using vulgar or abrasive language, or displaying rude or improper manners will not be tolerated and may result in discipline by the School Administration
5. Report any threats, bullying or misconduct that may jeopardize safety of students, faculty and staff
6. Students are generally prohibited from using mobile and electronic devices in the prayer hall, when classes are in session and during any exam. However, students may use electronic devices for educational purposes only with specific permission by a Teacher

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C. Parents Responsibilities

1. Parents should be involved with the School and teachers throughout the entire school year to ensure proper communication
2. Parents should review their child's class rules and grading policies at the beginning of the year to understand the expectations for the year.
3. Parents are expected to see that their child arrives at school properly groomed and dressed in attire that is neat, clean and modest
4. Parents are to drop-off/ pick up their children on time. **The Sunday school assumes no responsibility for supervising the school children after school hours**
5. Provide emergency contact information that can be reached during school hours as needed.
